[*b* 13 July 1767 at Johnston, RI; *d* 9 June 1839 at Onondaga, NY] Turner *m* 1st Mary Field [*b* 23 May 1773; *d* 12 March 1816 age 43 at Onandaga, NY] ca. 1789 in Cranston, RI.^a Mary was the daughter of William Field. Turner Fenner built the first sawmill on the west branch of Onondaga creek, in what is now Onondaga, in 1793. He was one of the first settlers in Onondaga County. He also kept a hotel at Budlong Corners. Turner *m* 2nd Rheua Hickok [*b* 18 July 1778; * *d* 26 Sept. 1839, age 61 yrs., 2 mos., 8 days] on 16 Oct. 1816 in NYC. Turner was in the Revolutionary War and the War of 1812. Turner, Mary, and Rheua are buried in the South Onondaga Cemetery.

Stephen was a Justice of the Peace in Cranston, and he was also a revolutionary soldier.

[*b* 25 Oct. 1736; *d* 1811] Samuel *m* Amey Fiske [*b* ca. 1735; * *d* 22 Mar. 1823 in Cranston in her 89th yr.] on 6 Sept. 1764 at Cranston, RI. Amey was the daughter of Phindras Fiske. Samuel's will was dated Sept. 28, 1811.^a

12335 THOMAS FENNER AND PHEBE HAYNES

[*b* 30 July 1744; *d* 14 Feb. 1827,^a age 82 yrs., 6 mo. at Fairfield, NY] Thomas was born in Cranston, RI. He *m* Phebe Haynes [*d* Oct. 31, 1823], daughter of William Haynes, between Middletown and Little Falls, NY. Thomas and Phebe deeded land in North Scituate, RI to Edward Fenner of Johnston in 1779.

They sold property in Scituate, RI and moved to Berkshire Co., MA in the neighborhood of Adams, from which place he had the following service in the Revolutionary War: He was a private in Capt. Samuel Law's Company, in Col. Symonds' Berkshire County Regiment. He enlisted 27 Oct. 1780, and was discharged 28 Oct. 1780; 2 days by order of Gen. Fellows on an alarm at the Northward. He also served in Capt. Levi Brown's Company in Adams, and Col. Asa Barnes' Berkshire County Regiment. He enlisted 31 Oct. 1781, and joined the army under Gen. Stark at Saratoga.

His will is signed 29 Oct. 1822, and probated 21 Feb. 1827, filed in Herkimer, Herkimer Co., NY.

[*b* 7-18 Jan. 1745] Daniel Fenner *m* Martha Bessel of Newport, RI on 4 Nov. 1764 at Cranston. Daniel served in the Revolutionary. Records show that Daniel was sick when Washington crossed the Delaware to attack the Hessians (Dec. 25, 1776) and was present at Valley Forge (Dec. 1777-June 1778). He was killed in a battle at Springfield, MA on 23 June 1780. Cranston undertook to get a pension for the widow. The census of 1790 names Martha as the head of the family in Providence, with one son over 16, one son under 16, and one daughter.

[*b* 1760 at Providence, RI; *d* 14 Jan. 1799 in his 40th yr.] James was buried on the Asahel Fenner farm. He and his brother, Joseph, received their grandfather's homestead farm in Cranston. In Sept. of 1780, the Cranston Town Council adjudged James *non compos mentis* and Richard Sarle was appointed his guardian for business affairs. Between 1787 and 1799, James lived at 1538 Plainfield Road, Cranston, RI. James married Sarah Remington^{a,b} [*b* ca. 1766 at Johnston, RI; *d* Apr. 1849, age 83] in 1790. In 1801, about two years after James died, Sarah was appointed guardian of James' children. James is buried in the Pocasset Cemetery in Cranston. By 1820, Sarah had moved to 43 Stony Acre Drive in Cranston. She *m* 2nd Job Sheldon [*b* ca. 1778; *d* 19 Feb. 1825, age 47].
