Son, Atty. Geo.L. Jr,[1913-2001] referred to above, donated a majority of his real estate to the PA Dept of Games and Wildlife and, even tho he was a graduate of Wyoming Seminary, Princeton University and Dickerson College, he granted Fenner Hall [his residence after the '72 Agnus Flood] and Fenner Greens [w/ prize winning roses and grapes gardens] to Wilkes University.
